Safety Instructions Safety Instructions

"Safety Instruction" cards must be given to each camper as soon as they have set up camp, and must be drafted, depending on the customer, in several languages (one language per card).

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

FLOODING - COASTAL STORMS

All campers will be informed of the order to evacuate by the manager of the camping site.

In these circumstances, keep calm and scrupulously follow these instructions:

- 1. Close outside gas supplies and cut off the electricity
- 2. Make for higher ground or muster points as quickly as possible
- 3. Only take your identity papers, money and valuable objects with you
- 4. Leave your vehicle and your camping equipment
- 5. Do not take refuge in caravans (in the case of severe flooding or coastal storms, they can be carried away)
- 6. Do not return until instructed to do so

Consult the evacuation plan for the camping site at reception and in the sink and toilet units, etc. Note your escape route to the muster point in advance. Evacuation routes are indicated by the logo below:

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

LAND MOVEMENTS

Indicate to the manager of the camping site:

- the appearance of cracks in the ground
- the appearance of ground settling or subsiding
- the falling of rocks or stones
- · any indication of potential instability

The manager will give you the appropriate instructions.

In the case of falling rocks or land movement:

- 1. Move away as soon as possible from the danger area
- 2. Do not return until instructed to do so
- 3. Immediately inform the manager of the camping site

SAFETY INSTRUCTION

FOREST FIRES

If you see the start of a fire, keep calm.

- 1. Close outside gas bottles.
- 2. Immediately warn the management of the camping site, who will alert the fire brigade.
- 3. Never approach a fire, either on foot, or by car.
- 4. Keep approach roads and evacuation routes clear.
- 5. Move in the opposite direction of the fire.

SAFETY INSTRUCTION

TECHNOLOGICAL RISKS

(Industrial, nuclear or the transport of dangerous goods)

In the case of a serious technological incident whose effects go beyond the surrounding wall of the industrial plant, the occupants of the camping site will be alerted by the alarm signal given by the SRP (Specific Response Plan) sirens present on risk sites.

The alarm can also be given by cars equipped with loudspeakers (depending on the incident, fire trucks, police or town hall vehicles).

The alarm signal is given by a siren sounding 3 times for 1 minute, separated by a short silence (national alarm code).

The end of the alert is announced by a siren sounding continuously, without changing tone, for 30 seconds. This signal indicates that the danger is over and that compliance with the safety instructions is no longer necessary.

Depending on the situation, the operator can sound the alarm with whatever means are available (sound system, megaphone etc.)

Orders to apply as soon the alarm is given:

- Do not take refuge in caravans, tent or vehicles (they are not sufficiently airtight)
- 2. Leave your vehicle and your camping equipment at the camping site
- 3. Go to the nearest shelter
- 4. Do not try to find your family
- 5. When you are in the shelter:
- close all openings toward the outside (doors, windows)
- stop the ventilation and air-conditioning
- keep away from doors and windows
- do not smoke, light a fire, or make sparks
- do not telephone
- wash yourself in case of skin irritation and if possible change your clothes
- listen to the radio (transistor radio)
